BAXI LUNA HT BOILERS QUALIFY FOR U.S. FEDERAL TAX CREDITS FOR ENERGY EFFICIENCY

On February 17, 2009, President Obama signed a stimulus bill (The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009) that made some significant changes to the energy efficiency tax credits. As the exclusive distributor of Baxi products for North America, we were delighted to learn that our Baxi Luna HT modulating, condensing boilers qualify for this program.

Highlights include: the tax credit has been raised from 10% to 30% (with maximum for the two years up from \$500 to \$1,500), and the program has been extended to 2010. Gas boilers with thermal efficiency of 90% or greater are eligible for the tax credits.

All Baxi Luna wallhung boilers, as listed on www.energystar.gov, conform to strict energy efficiency guidelines set by the US Environmental Protection Agency and the Department of Energy. Our Baxi Luna HT modulating, condensing boilers (92.5% AFUE rated) all qualify for the Federal Tax Credits for Energy Efficiency; those models include:

- Baxi Luna HT 1.33
- Baxi Luna HT 380
- Baxi Luna HT 1.45
- Baxi Luna HT 1.65
- Baxi Luna HT 1.100
